The Graham Cracker: A Nutcracker Parody

Our reimagined holiday classic continues to bring joy, laughter, and inclusion to Louisville audiences each December. In 2024, the production moved to the iconic Actors Theatre of Louisville, drawing our largest audiences to date. Blending student and professional dancers, this beloved show celebrates community, creativity, and visibility. Now a cornerstone of our season, The Graham Cracker proves that dance can be festive, subversive, and radically welcoming. Since 2022, ticket sales have grown by 34%, underscoring its growing impact and appeal.

Marking It: A NACHMO Exhibition

The 2025 NACHMO Festival participation grew 46% in 2024, featuring 121 performers from 12 organizations. In 2026, our annual choreographic incubator evolves into a joyful, low-barrier comedy dance performance paired with a curated photography show. Designed for accessibility, play, and creative risk-taking, "Marking It" welcomes dancers of all levels to simply create and connect.

Introducing the Kentucky Dance Festival

Launching March 13–15, 2026, at Actors Theatre, KDF is Kentucky's first regional contemporary dance festival. Featuring two professional concerts, a student showcase, artist workshops, and rural outreach, KDF creates a statewide platform for movement artists to thrive—without having to leave the Commonwealth.

Well Behaved Womxn...

This multi-generational project reclaims feminist narratives through original choreography rooted in literature, history, and personal storytelling. Through artistic residencies in JCPS dance programs, community ensemble engagement, and performances by Ambo's School and professional company, this production centers on underrepresented stories of survival, identity, and resistance. The work culminates in two powerful June 2026 productions: family- and sensory-friendly matinees, and evening performances of three new professional works—Carmilla, Medusa, and Mimi—exploring queer desire, mythic injustice, and autonomy through movement.
